Heart disease is the number one killer in women, regardless of race or ethnicity, claiming more lives than all forms of cancer combined. Dr. Van Herle will focus on awareness of cardiovascular disease risk in women and some of the ways in which heart disease presents in women, as well as some novel screening that USC does in otherwise healthy women to assess their risk.

Prior to receiving her medical degree, Helga Van Herle received a master's degree in bioengineering from Columbia University. In 1993, Van Herle received her M.D. from the University of California Los Angeles. She then completed her internal medicine residency training at the New York Hospital-Cornell University Medical Center. She completed a cardiology fellowship at the University of California Los Angeles. Before joining USC, she was on the faculty at UCLA. She is an expert in cardiology consultation for organ transplantation and serves as the primary point person for this work at USC. In addition, she is a staff physician at the Women's Cardiovascular Center, which is a part of the USC Cardiovascular Thoracic Institute.
