Career Journey in the Arts: Successes and Challenges

Rochelle Steiner, originally from Los Angeles was appointed Dean of the Roski School of Fine Arts at the University of Southern California in August, 2010. Dean Steiner earned her PhD and MA degrees in Visual and Cultural Studies (Art History) from the University of Rochester, and a BA from Syracuse University in English and Advertising. In 2009 she was one of ten fellows selected from U.S. museums for the Center for Curatorial Leadership program.

A recognized curator and writer, she organized over 60 major art exhibitions and large-scale public art projects in the United States and Europe. Under her leadership as Director of the non-profit organization, Public Art Fund in New York, she commissioned 35 public art projects with established and emerging international artists, including Olafur Eliasson's *The New York City Waterfalls*.

Dean Steiner will share some of own career journey, what skills she obtained, what obstacles she encountered, and what she learned from this journey.
